## DYXnet Group's 1H13 Revenue Grows 30%

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Demonstrating the Continued Growth in MPLS VPN & Contact Centre Businesses

MPLS VPN and contact centre businesses recorded increases of 27% and 40% respectively.

Capitalizing on the opportunity, the Group's cloud data centre in Shanghai already started its operation in the third quarter of 2013.
